1. All Boats must be able to carry 2 anglers plus a weighmaster, and still be within safe boating guidelines as laid out by transport Canada. Weighmaster will have their own lifejacket and weigh scale all scales will be provide by tournament weighmasters and are the Rapala type to be consistant with weights.

2. Teams will be notified aprox 2 weeks in advance of fishing time period but location will be given out 1 day before and no prefishing will be allowed once lake is anounced. Anglers will be grouped as close to preferred time slots as possible.

3.The fishing period will be 3hrs long with the final match being 6 hrs of fishing with break in middle with all fish over required length,(to be determined at launch) being weighed buy weighmaster on board and recorded manually with lunkers being photographed for proof and immediatly returned to the water in a gentle manner.

4. All weighable fish are to be clipped on scale by angler and weight verified by angler and weighmaster before it is released.

5.All fish are to be handled in a respectable manner

- **Penalties**

- A 1 minute penalty will be given to both anglers for any fish that lands on the boat floor or carpet or is mishandled . **ex.** Excessive digging for hook removal causing excessive bleeding , throwing fish from any higher than top rail of boat.
- A net may be used to land fish but there will be a 1 minute penalty

6.Winner will be the team with the most weight at the end of the 3 hr fishing time. In the event of a tie the team with the heaviest fish wins, if still tied the team with the most fish caught and weighed wins. If its still tied there will be a fish off right there at the launch.The first fish caught wins if still legal fishing light, if not the 2 teams will fish the next qualifying event and highest weight of the 2 teams move on finals.

7.There will be no live or prepared bait with the exception of pork rind.

8.No underwater cameras can be used during fishing times.

9 No Trolling will be permitted .

10. Only 1 rod can be used by each angler at a time but, others can be rigged and ready for use.

11.All laws and equipment regarding Small Craft, and Federal Fisheries must be followed.

12.Fishing Liscences are required to participate in this tournament.

13.No Drugs or alcohol is permitted before or during Tournament any violations will be disqualified and asked to leave.

14.No angler is allowed to leave the boat except (nature calls) but partner is not allowed to fish while partner is out of boat.

15 This will be a shotgun start tournament except the final championship match which will be numbered start with break in middle and resart in reverse order.

16.The onboard weighmasters are the official time keepers and weighers. All Anglers are to be sportsman and treat the weighmaster as officials of the tournament committee. Any violation of this will result in disqualification.
